The career fair operates in a format where students visit three immersive sessions in a variety of STEM career pathways. Local businesses and HCC faculty develop and facilitate presentations and activities designed to help create a clearer understanding of the career opportunities in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics). STEM careers are concentrated in the following fields: Advanced Manufacturing, Agriculture, Agricultural Operations, Computer and Informational Sciences Engineering and Engineering Technologies, Biological and Biomedical Sciences, Mathematics and Statistics, Physical Sciences, and Technologies.

Below are summaries of three of twenty of the presentations being offered:

Genetics

Isolate DNA from a banana, or conduct a chemical test to discover the genetics behind why things taste good or bad to you.

Gaming 101

In this session students will explore the world of video game production. This includes the basics of game design as well as exploring the concepts of web programming as it relates to the development and building of video games. Students will participate in the production of their own video game.

Etiquette allows you to present yourself in a polished, professional and polite way. It encourages others to take you seriously. While you may immediately think of etiquette in a dining situation, etiquette reflects proper behavior in all situations.
